

Using NoRedInk at home

Dear students,

During this time of distance learning, we'll be using **NoRedInk** to help you continue growing as writers! You should already have a NoRedInk account that you've been using at school, and this letter contains instructions to help you log in at home so that you can continue working on your assignments.

Log in to your NoRedInk account

First, make sure you know how to log in to your existing account ([Read this article for help!](#)) Do you use a username or email address and password, or do you “Log in with Google” at school?

- Go to www.noredink.com/login and enter your information to log in. If you're using an email address to log in and you've forgotten your password, use the “Forgot?” option to reset it
- It's important that you log in to the same account you're been using at school, so if you can't remember how to log in or if you get stuck trying, please let me know!
